School Resources

DoDEA recently purchased access to a great website (SchooLinks) to help students plan for school to career success. I recently challenged all middle school students to use this tool to plan out all the courses they may take leading up to graduation. We refer to this as a 6-year plan for 6th graders, a 5-year plan for 7th graders, and a 4-year plan for 8th graders. The instructions for how middle schoolers do this can be found in an extended video I made and sent out to all students' gmail. I know it's a flawed process in the sense that few of our students will be seniors here, but it's still an important exercise for students.

If you want access to SchooLinks, you will get the most out of it by looking at it with your child. It is possible to get access as a parent to SchooLinks (follow <u>this link</u>). Currently, parent access does not provide a way to see results of your child's Assessments, School Search preferences, or the Course Planner, and is largely limited to the Career tab. DECEMBER 2 - 8TH IS NATIONAL GRIEF AWARENESS WEEK.



Dear Parent or Guardian:

Spangdahlem Middle School will participate in the 2024 National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) on February 29th, 2024. NAEP is the largest nationally representative and continuing assessment of what students know and can do in various subjects. NAEP is administered by the National Center for Education Statistics, within the U.S. Department of Education. NAEP is different from our state assessments because it is a common measure of achievement across the country. The results are released as The Nation's Report Card, which provides information about student achievement to educators, parents/guardians, policymakers, and the public.

Your child will take a mathematics or reading assessment. In addition to subject-area questions, students voluntarily complete NAEP survey questions. These questions provide valuable information about participating students' educational experiences and opportunities to learn both in and outside of the classroom. Additionally, American Indian and Alaska Native (AI/AN) students will be included in the National Indian Education Study (NIES). NIES describes the condition of education for AI/AN students in the United States. More information about NAEP survey questions is available at https://nces.ed.gov/nationsreportcard/parents under the section "What Questions Are on the Test?"

The assessment takes about 120 minutes for most students, which includes transition time, directions, and completion of survey questions.

The information collected is used for statistical purposes only.

- Your child's grades will <u>not</u> be affected.
- Students may be excused for any reason, are not required to complete the assessment, and may skip any question.
- While the assessment is voluntary, NAEP depends on student participation to help policymakers improve education. However, if you do not want your child to participate, please notify me in writing by <u>31 January 2024</u>.

There is no need to study in preparation for NAEP, but please encourage your child to do their best. Contact Dr. Elaine Wiedemer at <u>Elaine.Wiedemer@dodea.edu</u> if you have any questions.

We are excited that our school is participating in NAEP. We know that Spangdahlem Middle School's students will show what our nation's students know and can do!
